
MIBI HEAT MAP REFLECTING 2017 CLAIMS ON A PER CAPTIA BASIS




Claims are expressed (normalised) on the basis of claims per 100,000 of population to assist comparisons between counties.

It can be seen that more rural counties with lower populations often have higher per capita accident rates, such as Cavan and Longford.


HEAT MAP REFLECTING 2017 MIBI CLAIMS DATA
